Current IPM practices for managing turf disease focus mainly on modifying environmental conditions or reaching for "go-to" fungi-toxic fungicides to control the pathogen. Until now, managing the plant side of the equation has usually required sodding, seeding or sprigging to renovate to better turf types.

The well-known disease management triangle is formed by the three agronomic factors involved in plant disease: a suitable host plant, the presence of an infectious pathogen (a microorganism that causes the disease), and suitable environmental conditions for the pathogen to infect and grow. To effectively control plant diseases.

these three factors need to be managed so that they become less favorable to the pathogen.
